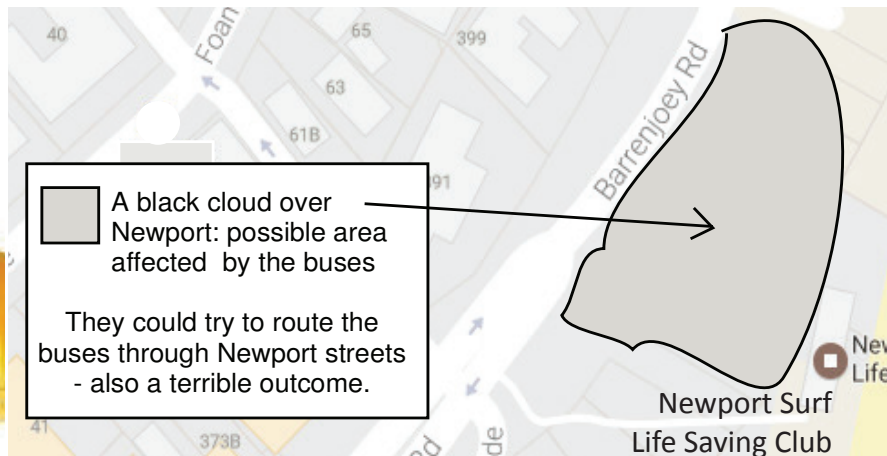


Stop the **destruction** of **Newport** surf **carpark**
