On demand public transport trial

As part of the NSW Government's Future Transport Technology Roadmap, new trial service **Keoride** will be providing connections to the new B-Line on the Northern Beaches from the **end of November 2017**.



What is Keoride?

Keoride is a new On Demand Transport service for people who want to reach their destination quickly, safely, and at a time that suits them. It's a ride sharing service that provides first and last mile connections to the new B-Line bus service using small GoGet passenger cars.

Which areas will Keoride service?

There are two operational On Demand zones:

- Zone 1 North Narrabeen to Mona Vale
- Zone 2 Mona Vale to Palm Beach

The Northern Beaches pilot will commence at the end of November 2017 and operate 7 days per week in these timeframes:

- Weekdays 6am 10pm
- Saturday 7am 7pm
- Sunday 7am 5pm

How much does Keoride cost?

Each Keoride trip costs \$3.10. That's it! You can book as many trips as you like in advance, but please note we collect funds at the time of booking, so you'll need to cancel your journey if your plans change.

Opal is not configured for the pilot, so payment can be made by Credit Card.
