

Notification of night work on Barrenjoey Road, Newport and Newport Beach car park from Tuesday 6 March

The NSW Government is delivering improved public transport between the Northern Beaches and the Sydney CBD. This includes service and infrastructure upgrades to provide a new B-Line bus service. The B-Line is providing a more frequent, reliable, turn-up-and-go bus service for customers travelling between Mona Vale and the Sydney CBD, with services proposed to be extended to Newport in 2018.

Details of work activities

Roads and Maritime Services will conduct service and geotechnical investigation work in Newport. This will help us to understand the sand, earth and rock beneath the asphalt in the area, as well as where existing water, sewer and electricity sites are located.

The information gathered will assist in the development of the Review of Environmental Factors (REF) for the proposed roundabout at the intersection of Barrenjoey Road and Neptune Road. The REF is expected to be placed on public display for comment in the coming months.

Where and when?

The work will be carried out on Barrenjoey Road, near the intersection with Neptune Road. There will also be some investigation in the Newport beach car park adjacent to Barrenjoey Road.

Work will occur **over one night and two days:**

- **Night work: Tuesday 6 March**
- **Day work: Wednesday 7 and Thursday 8 March**
(weather permitting)

Work hours:

- **Night work: 7pm to 5am**
- **Day work: 7am to 6pm**

The work will involve drilling into the ground to conduct service investigations and soil sampling.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with this work but we will make every effort to minimise it by completing the noisier work before 11pm.

- concrete saws
- power and hand tools
- lighting equipment
- generators
- drill rig
