| Newport Oval – shipping container storage | The container stores gameday equipment for Mona Vale Junior Rugby League Club. The container has been relocated in response to community feedback. The container placement is approved by Council and is a temporary arrangement until improvements to the amenities building at Newport Oval are undertaken (currently unfunded). |
| Trafalgar Park – playground upgrade | Consultation closed 1 October. Council is finalising design plans with construction scheduled in April/May 2024. |
| Robertson Road - outdoor dining bays | Council owns and maintains the umbrellas. Any attached plastic clears are not maintained by Council. |
| EV Charging Point – Dearin Reserve (Kalinya Street) | The introduction of an <i>Intellihub</i> Streetside Electric Vehicle Charging point was approved by Council in November. Installation of the equipment is scheduled to occur in mid- December (weather permitting). |
