ltem	Update
Robertson Road	Dining pods have been repaired (spot rendered) and painted. Vehicle wheel stops have been painted.
Newport Surf Club Car Park – Ausgrid lights	Ausgrid has advised that 'complex maintenance' is required to repair the lights (including repairs to underground network).
	Ausgrid estimates that repairs will be completed by 30 November.
	Ausgrid has installed temporary lighting in the car park to help address concerns raised by the community.
Draft Waste and Circular Economy Strategy	Council's draft strategy is currently on exhibition, and feedback is being received until Sunday, 10 December.

EV Charging stations	Jolt - charging point
	A Jolt vehicle charging point was proposed for The Boulevard (opposite the Newport Community Centre).

Jolt advised that they had some concerns regarding potential isolated flooding in the location, which could not be adequately mitigated. Council is now working with Jolt to identify and alternate location in Newport.

## Intellihub charging point

Multiple locations across the LGA were proposed for the introduction of an Intellihub vehicle charger point (12-month trial). This included a space adjacent to Dearin Reserve, Newport.



Council received 149 submissions in support of the Newport location.

At the November meeting of the Northern Beaches Council Local Traffic Committee, the Newport location was endorsed as one of the trial locations where Intellihub chargers will be installed and trialled.
