Proposed Raised Pedestrian Crossing - Gladstone Street, Newport

Council has received requests from local residents to improve pedestrian access and safety across Gladstone Street near the intersection with Bishop Street, Newport.

Council's Transport Network team carried out further investigations including traffic counts with the data indicating that traffic and pedestrian volumes meet the Transport for NSW (TfNSW) guidelines and warrant criteria for the installation of a pedestrian crossing. Council proposes to install a raised pedestrian crossing with kerb blisters to narrow the crossing point and improve traffic calming in the area. A concept plan is enclosed with this letter for your information.

Council invites you to submit your comments on this proposal. Please respond with <u>Support</u> or <u>Non-Support</u> followed by any additional comments by **9 November 2020**. Your comments will only be considered if they include your name and address. Please note that individual responses will not be provided.

Written submissions can be posted to PO Box 82, Manly NSW 1655, or alternatively you may email your comments to Council@northernbeaches.nsw.gov.au

Once feedback has been reviewed the matter may then be raised for consideration at the Northern Beaches Council Local Traffic Committee. The Traffic Committee's decision will be available on Council's website one week after the meeting. If the proposal is adopted by Council, the works will be included on the future Traffic Facilities program and delivered when resources are available and in order of priority from the list of approved projects.


