## CANDIDATES TO ADDRESS PITTWATER ELECTORS

Pittwater Community Alliance, a federation of 12 Pittwater community groups, will hold a public meeting with candidates to present their policies for the NSW State election on 23 March. This meeting will take place between 6.45am and 9.00pm on **Monday 11 March 2019**, in the Banksia Room at the **Nelson Heather Centre**, 4 Jacksons Road, Warriewood.

We have asked candidates to address the following questions:

- Will you vote independently on all issues?
- Are you a resident of Pittwater?
- Do you understand and support Pittwater's unique character?
- Are you committed to working hard for the community living in Pittwater?
- Will you consider matters on their merits and not on political or party grounds?
- Will you investigate the problems residents are having with the Northern Beaches Hospital and the ambulance services in Pittwater and work to improve emergency services at Mona Vale Hospital?
- Are you beholden to or funded by developer or lobby group interests?
- How are you allocating preferences?

Candidates will be asked to speak for up to 10 minutes and take audience questions for up to 10 minutes. If there is time, there may be a further opportunity for questions from the audience at the end of the presentations.

This is a public meeting. It is possible that the media may attend, and there may be the possibility of still photos or video/sound recording.
