Thank you again for allowing me to attend the Newport Residents Association meeting on 19 March. It was a great opportunity to meet your members and listen to their issues and concerns.

I noted the actions below to follow up:

**Mona Vale Hospital –**

Action - what is Council's position on the hospital.

Response – Council has not resolved a position on Mona Vale Hospital, it is a State Government matter, and this would be a decision for our elected council.

**Royal Motor Yacht Club –**

Action – would a boom-gate with number plate recognition require a DA.

Response - Yes – approval would be required for the installation of boom gates as the proposed development does not form exempt development under the States Environmental Planning Policies (SEPP). However, they already have approval for the boom gates under a 2015 DA, (N0379/15) which would mean they could upgrade what is currently there without approval.

**Development Assessments –**

Action – advise when the old DAs will be transferred into the new system.

Response – The DAs from the previous three councils have been transferred into an electronic system and date back to 2003.

If the DA is earlier than that you can apply for a Property File Search through an informal GIPA application.

**Newport Oval –**

Action – organise a meeting with staff to discuss the white picket fence and amenities upgrade.

Response – Trish will organise an onsite meeting with NRA members and the Executive Manager, Parks and Reserves, Steven Lawler.
