Consultation – Timed Parking Restriction – Queens Parade, Newport

Council has received concerns from residents regarding the limited parking within the carpark on Queens Parade, Newport.

As the Kindergarten drop off and pickup area is no longer required, Council has undertaken a review of the above location and proposes additional timed parking spaces. The proposed timed parking restriction will be '1P 8:30am – 8:00pm MON to SAT' and '4P 8:30am – 8:00pm SUN & PUBLIC HOLIDAYS'. This will align with the existing parking restrictions in the area.


A concept plan is enclosed with this letter for your information.

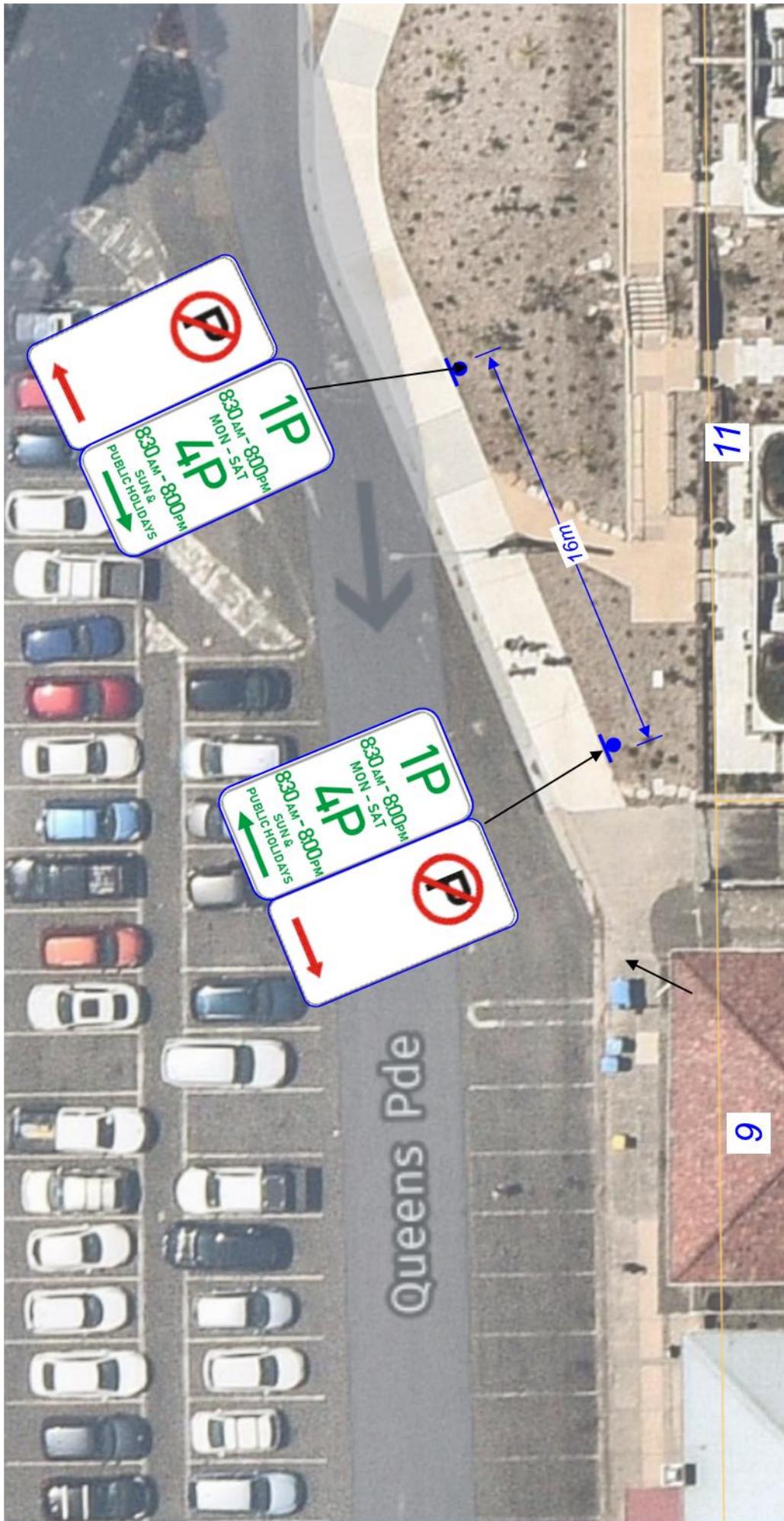

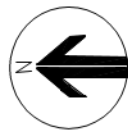
